The Restaurant & Bar

The Fosshotel Húsavík restaurant has a distinct personality with dominant whale-themed decor. At the restaurant, you can enjoy a drink or two before or after an exciting day in the Húsavík area. 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Conference

Skjálfandi is the flagship conference venue at Fosshotel Húsavík. Skjálfandi is a (245 m²) venue and can take up to 230 guests. It is beautifully decorated and features multi-color LED lighting, with a special feature of Aurora Borealis lighting. Skjálfandi is the perfect venue for large groups in North Iceland.

Þingey is the second largest conference room at Fosshotel Húsavík. Located on the ground floor, Þingey is an ideal place to host receptions, private meals and meetings. The venue is about 89sqm and can take up to 80 guests in a standing reception. Fosshotel Húsavík offers 6 other venues. Most are fully equipped with the latest technical equipment and all are ideally suited for board meetings or smaller meetings.

Sitting on the west side of Skjálfandi bay, Húsavík has earned a global recognition as one of the best whale watching areas in the world. In fact, you are more likely to see whales in Húsavík than any other place in Iceland. The reason for that is the thriving ecosystem in the bay. Most typical whale visitors to Skjálfandi bay are the humpbacks, minke, and blue whale. These whales are amongst the most entertaining animals to watch at sea and lucky whale watchers may get to see them feeding, jumping out, slapping and poking their head out of the water.
