Fosshotel Eastfjords is a beautiful three-star hotel in Fáskrúðsfjörður near Reyðarfjörður, which is in the centre of the Eastfjords. The hotel was renovated in 2016 and is in a historic building built in 1903 and previously used as a hospital for French fishermen.

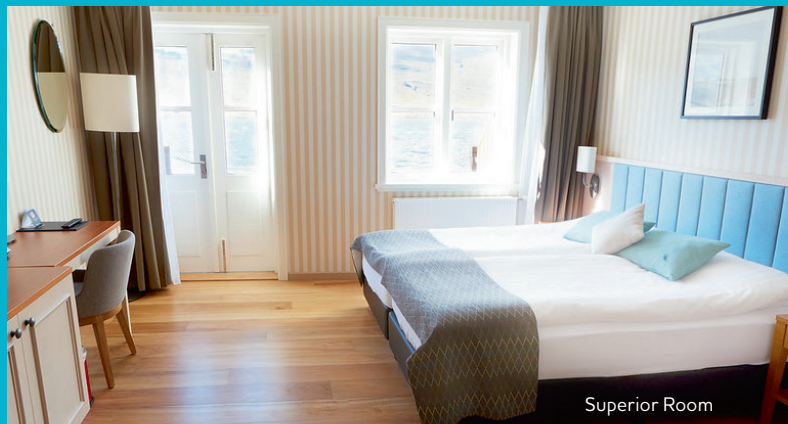
## Room types

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## L'Abri Restaurant

L'Abri is a French-inspired restaurant overlooking the Dock of Fáskrúðsfjörður offering a great view over the fjord. The cuisine is French and Scandinavian based where local ingredients from local farmers and fishermen play a key role. Feel free to check out the museum connected to the restaurant and dedicated to the French fishermen that used to frequent these shores either before or after dinner.



## The museum

Fosshotel Eastfjords is in a historic building built in 1903 and used as a hospital for French fishermen until 1939, when the house was disassembled and moved. In 2008 it was decided to reassemble the house in its original location. The hotel includes a museum devoted to the French fishermen.
