







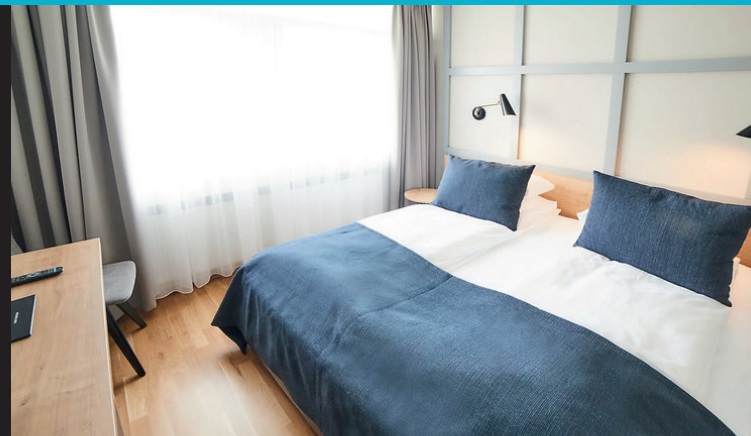
Spectacular surroundings and natural wonders
